With the demand for eco-timber and milling, one of the instructors at the demonstration said their newly introduced frame is very handy and labour

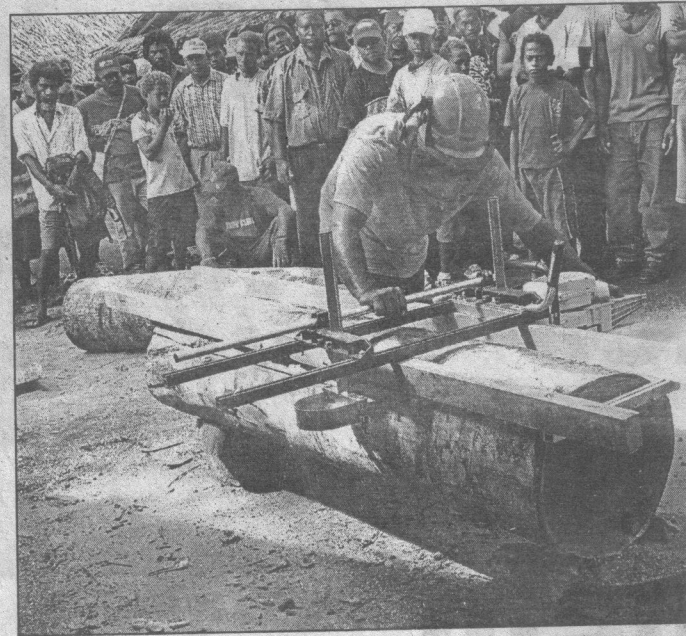
efficient.
