

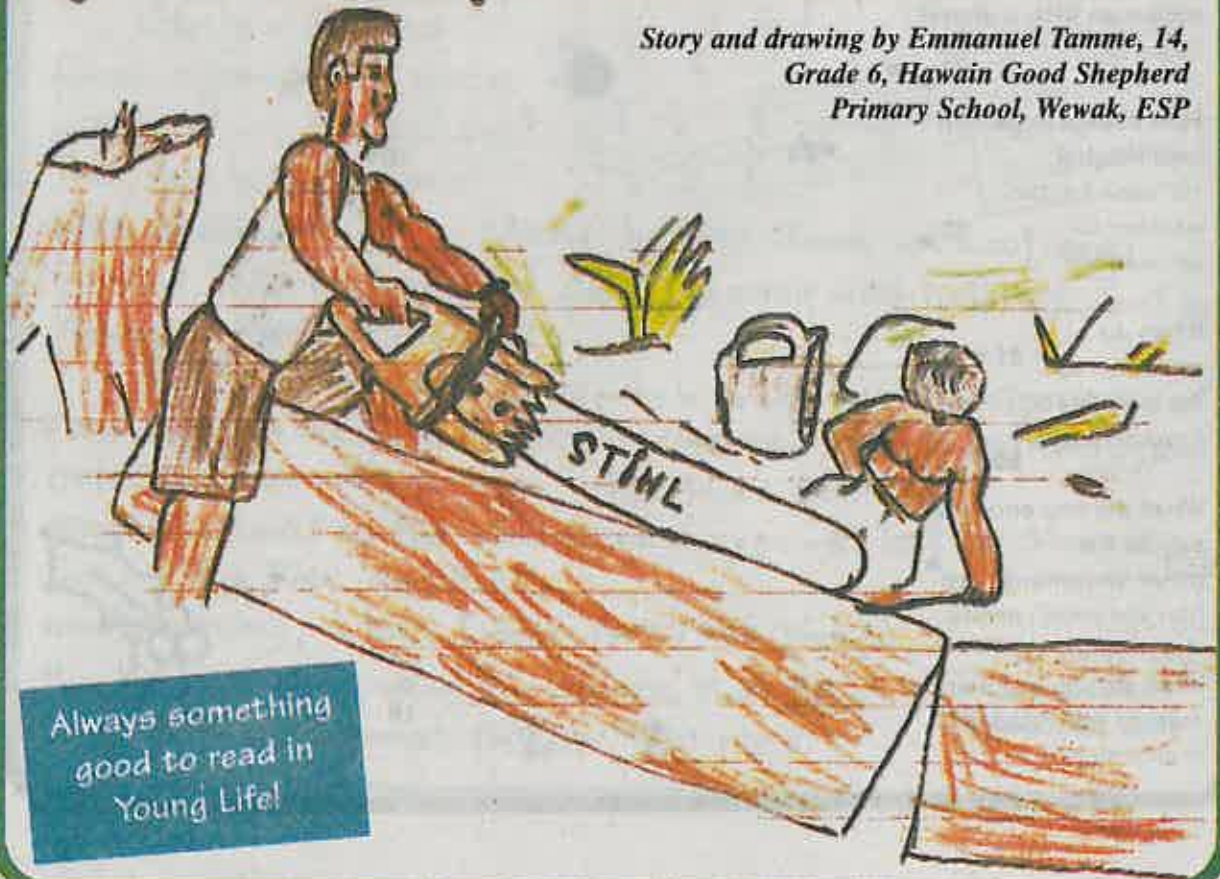
The simplest and cheapest way to get sawn timber
 First of all we go to the bush and my father selects a suitable tree and chops it down with the chain saw. Then he cut it to the required length. Then we use the chalk to mark the center of the center of the log.

One of us pull the line and let it snap on the log to have a straight line on the log. Then father used the chain saw to rip the log into equal halves.

After that we lay one of the halves with flat side up, father again marks the required sizes to be cut into slabs, and the chalk line is pulled, snaps.

Then slabs are ripped using a slabbing mill and saw. By the end of the day we have all timber we need.
